Buckle Up - Its the Law



Intro: This is something that once we get into the habit of doing, we almost do it automatically. If we don't, it can cost us so we need to get into the habit. The same thing goes for the spiritual life. There are some things we need to get in the habit of buckling up so we can avoid struggles, loneliness and fear. Lets think about it for a while today.

- I. Things to buckle up
- A. Our Spiritual Armor Ephesians 6:10-18
  - 1. The girdle of truth V14

**Thought:** Satan is a liar but the Christian who knows the truth will not be deceived by his lies. How well do you know the word? This is why biblical education is so important.

2. The Breastplate of Righteousness V 14

Thought: Right living guards the heart against the assault of the enemy. Remember, we can't do right till we are right.

So our righteousness is actually Christ's righteousness that has been imputed to our account. The key is not just that it has been charged to our account, but it is no good if we do not buckle it on and use it for right just because He has already made us right.

3. The shoes of the Gospel V 15

Why this part? Our answer is found in Psalm 119:89 Because it is the only thing in the universe besides God himself that is settled forever. So what better thing to walk with.

Also remember passages such as Psalm 119:97-104

4. The shield of faith V 16 Hebrews 11:6

Faith never grows in a disobedient, fearful heart so lets be obedient and buckle it on and by faith, trust God for great things in our lives.

**Thought:** Remember, only those who see the invisible can do the impossible and we can see the invisible only through the eyes of faith. Do you have your faith shield buckled on today?

5. Then we need to buckle up the helmet of salvation V 17

If you don't know you have this helmet buckled on, then you probably don't. I can tell if I have this helmet on or not and so can you. I John 5:13

- 6. Then we need to buckle on the Sword of the Spirit V 17

**Thought:** The devil in not afraid of a dust covered Bible. So dust it off and buckle it on as part of your armor.

Thought: Someone said it quite well; using your Bible as a road map will keep you off the detours of life.

- D. Finally, buckle up some dreams **Thought**: God often gives in one brief moment, what he has for a long time denied.

Our problem is that we quit dreaming because we get discouraged. So lets buckle up once again in this area of our lives.

Question: Are you buckled up? Its a law in the nation but it is a spiritual law as well. We need to buckle up, not to avoid fines, but to gain victories.
