No Parking



Hebrews 12:1-3

Intro: The church is not to be a parking lot for unmotivated Christians. Our passage in Hebrews 12 says run the race and we can't run if we are parked in a pew. Lets think a while about this idea of parking or not parking.

I. Where not to park

A. In our old sins and self life II Corinthians 5:14-21

V 17 We are new creatures learning new things

V 20 We are ambassadors to go make appeals for Christ. To do this we can't park in the comfort of our old sins, our old desires, our old priorities etc.

B. We are also not to park in the spot called being satisfied with where we are spiritually. Paul wasn't!!

Philippians 3:12-14 V 13,14; We do need to think back on our lives and learn from our mistakes. We need to think about our disobedience long enough to seek God's mercy and then choose to "go and sin no more" Look back and learn but don't park back there.

Ephesians 4:11-16 V 13 This work must continue until we are all joined together in the same faith and in the same knowledge of the Son of God. We must become like a mature person, growing until we become like Christ and have his perfection. We are to constantly be maturing until we are mature.

Thought: When growth stops, decay begins

C. We are also not to park in the <u>being served section</u>, instead move on to the <u>serving</u> <u>section</u> pulling in only long enough for fuel to carry on. John 9:1-12 V 4

Thought: The Christian's place is on the front line, not on the sideline.

D. Don't park in **yesterdays victories** Lamentations 3:22,23 *The unfailing love of the LORD never ends! By his mercies we have been kept from complete destruction. Great is his* faithfulness; his mercies begin afresh each day.

Instead lets remember the words of this song and not try to lay our burdens down just yet. Lets continue to press on!! There are new areas yet to be conquered through God's new mercies each day.

You can not fight or win today's battles if you are resting on yesterday's battle victories. Yesterday's fight is over. Today's battle is today, not yesterday. If you would, just read the words of this song and be encouraged to keep on till you get home.
